# Unite the Energy Decision Makers to Forge the Net Zero Transition Pathway in Vietnam

With Annual GDP growth projected 5%+, Vietnam is one of the fastest growing economy and Power consumption in the country is projected to increase by 10-12 percent annually through to 2030.

Clean Energy Transition is one of the top priorities on the agenda of Vietnam's COP26 energy commitments while minimizing environmental impacts and making progress on broader sustainable development goals. To meet its goal of net-zero emissions by 2050, Viet Nam needs to massively increase its renewable energy capacity, particularly solar and wind.

The World Clean Energy Conference Vietnam Edition is scheduled at April 5-6, 2023 at Ho Chi Minh City Vietnam. 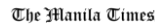

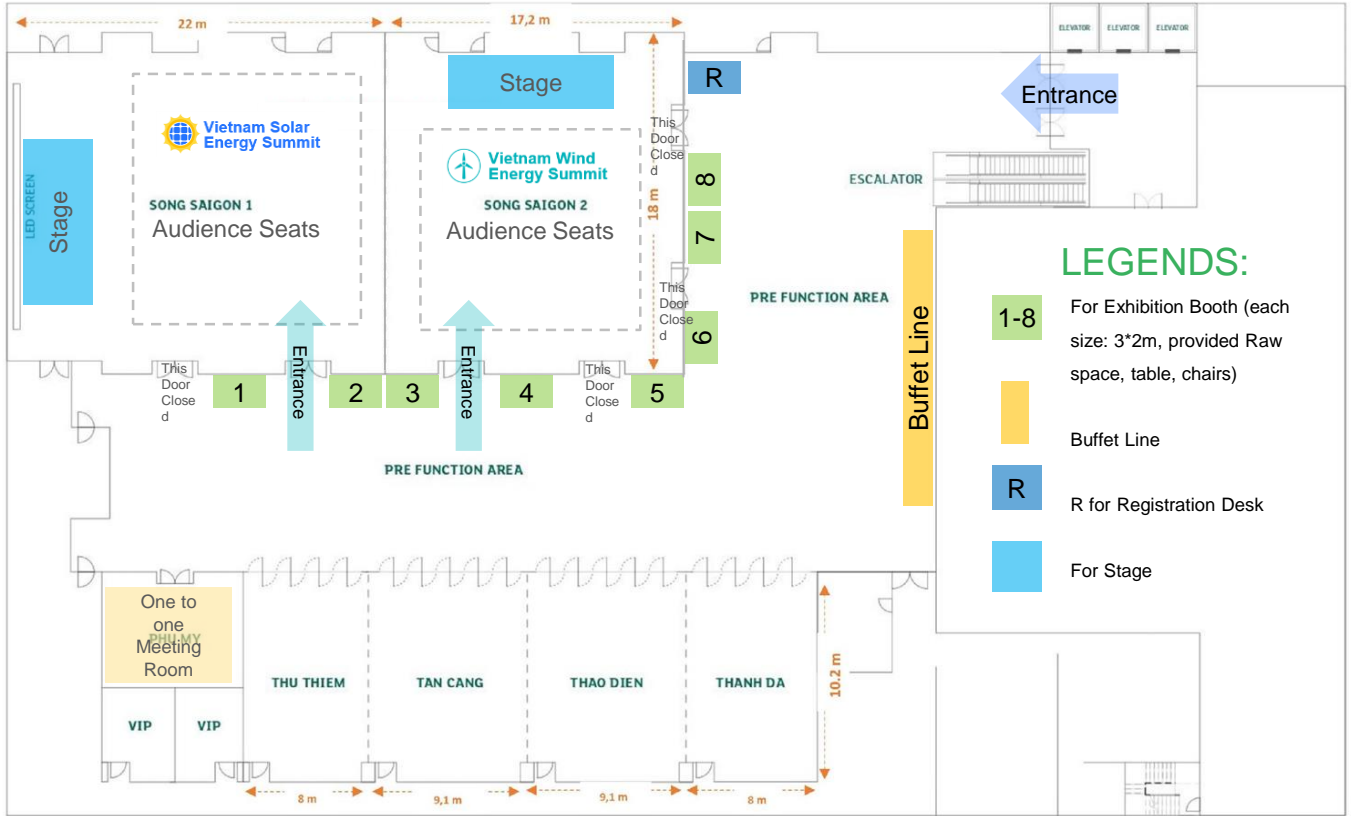
